WHEREAS, Through our laws we maintain our rights and liberties; and

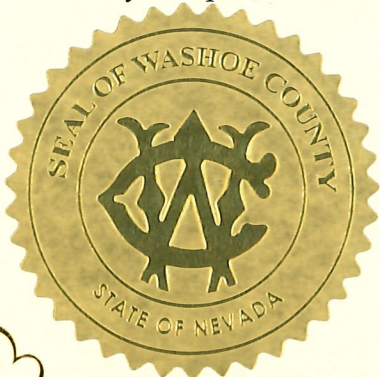
WHEREAS, With our laws we provide for equality and justice for all; and
