

AMENDMENT #8 TO AGREEMENT FOR

OUR PLACE WOMEN AND FAMILY SHELTER OPERATOR

THIS AMENDMENT #8 to the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT between the County of Washoe, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada (COUNTY) and Reno Initiative for Shelter and Equality ("OPERATOR" or "RISE") originally effective May 1, 2020 is made to revise the AGREEMENT as follows:

- A. Add \$457,313.00 (FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS) to the FY23 AGREEMENT term and subsequent renewal periods in support of the retention and recruitment of shelter staff and increased expenses due to inflation as a result of the COVID pandemic.

THEREFORE, the following contract sections are amended as follows:

Section 3 Compensation is hereby amended to increase the total not to exceed amount from \$2,300,000.00 (TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS) up to \$2,757,313.00 (TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS) annually, including subsequent renewal periods, if contract extensions are implemented. The implementation of contract extensions shall not require a written amendment unless changes in performance or compensation are also required.

Section 4. Method of Payment is hereby amended herein as follows:

Provided OPERATOR submits an invoice and report every two weeks showing the services provided as listed in the "Scope of Work" in Exhibit B. OPERATOR shall submit invoices based on actual expenses incurred and shall be paid in equal distributed monthly installments not to exceed the total contract amount.

This Amendment #8 hereby executes the renewal period from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

UNLESS PREVIOUSLY AMMENDED, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, all parties of the AGREEMENT hereto have set their hands and subscribed their signatures to effect this AMENDMENT #8 effective July 1, 2022.
