SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve a 2017 Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management in the amount of \$225,000.00 (requires a 25% County match in the amount of \$75,000.00); Grant Term: Retroactive from August 14, 2017 – March 22, 2021; If approved authorize the County Manager or his designee to sign the grant award documents when received; and authorize the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners is requested to approve the acceptance of a 2017 Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management to update to the Washoe County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Washoe County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Program will use the funds to hire a consultant through the RFP process to lead the region through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Update process. It is a requirement that this plan is updated every 5 years to remain eligible for future grant funding. This update will allow the jurisdictions to remain in compliance with FEMA directives while sustaining and improving regional mitigation actions. This process will validate ongoing actions, examine and confirm successful mitigation projects, determine what actions will encourage the completion of remaining projects, and focus the region on newly identified mitigation planning gaps such as closed basin flooding. The Board has previously accepted similar Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant awards to Washoe County.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities

PREVIOUS ACTION

February 26, 2008 – The Board of County Commissioners accepted the 2007 Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant from State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management,

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[\$38,406.75 with County match of \$12,802.25]; and directed the Finance Department to make appropriate budget adjustments.

June 17, 2014 – The Board of County Commissioners accepted the 2014 Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management, [\$110,000.00 with County match of \$27,500.00]; and directed the Finance Department to make appropriate budget adjustments.

BACKGROUND

To remain in compliance with the requirements of 44 C.F.R. Part 201 and FEMA/DHS regulations (DMA 2000 Sec. 322) it is a requirement to update the Washoe County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan every five years. This project will update, standardize and consolidate data to ensure that the region has a comprehensive approach to hazard mitigation that continues to create synergy and unity of effort. The jurisdictions included are Washoe County, Cities of Reno and Sparks, Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, and the Truckee River Flood Management Agency (TRFMA). To support this effort the federal government decided to repurpose and award mitigation funds from FFY-17. Although retroactive, FEMA/DHS understands that the project will not begin until fall 2018.
