BACKGROUND

Washoe County Regional Animals Services was the recipient of a cash donation in the amount of \$5,000.00 from Linda Platshon.

Donations are generally used to encourage responsible pet ownership, seek treatment of sick or injured animals, or at risk animals, and to promote humane treatment of animals.
