SUMMARY

The Agency has received an amendment to the 2019 Interlocal Agreement to Use Account for Low-Income Housing Welfare Set-Aside Funds by Washoe County between Washoe County and the Nevada housing Division of the State of Nevada Department of Business and Industry providing an in the amount of \$45,130.00 to provide emergency housing assistance in our community.

County Priority/Goal supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 25, 2018, item 6.K.3, the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2019 Interlocal Agreement to Use Account for Low-Income Housing Welfare Set-Aside Funds by Washoe County between Washoe County and the Nevada housing Division of the State of Nevada Department of Business and Industry in the amount of \$137,150.99 with no match.

On July 11, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved item #8 the Agency's request to accept Low-Income Housing Trust Funds for July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020.

The Washoe County Board of Commissioners has approved agreements for LIHTF set-aside funding since approximately 1990.

BACKGROUND

The Nevada Legislature increased the Low-Income Housing Trust Fund (LIHTF) in 1989. Fifteen percent of the LIHTF was set-aside to provide emergency housing assistance for individuals and families with children, This grant provides assistance to families and seniors in danger of becoming homeless or who are homeless and are in need to assistance with utilities, security deposits, rent or a mortgage payment. These funds are provided to each county in the state.

For FY2019-2021, Washoe County is eligible for LIHTF Welfare Set Aside funds in a new amount of \$182,280.99.
