WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$1,000 will be granted to Spanish Springs High School - JROTC Program to help support the annual "Shaw Christmas shopping trip"; and

WHEREAS, during the annual "Shaw Christmas shopping trip", Shaw Middle School counselors identify up to 20 students that come from underprivileged families that will likely have few resources for Christmas. As a service project, Spanish Springs High School JROTC purchase gifts from local businesses and wrap them for these families; and

**WHEREAS,** the mission of the Washoe County School District JROTC Silver State Brigade is to motivate young people to be better citizens; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants for the County by supporting the annual "Shaw Christmas shopping trip."
- 2. The Board hereby grants to the Spanish Springs High School JROTC Program, a grant for fiscal year 2017-2018 in the amount of \$1,000.
- 3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
