However, we raised more than \$20,000 for the charity.

From 2015- 2017 I sat on the committee to grow the endowment for the Sierra Arts Foundation which, among other things, provides art education to school aged children in the Washoe County School District.

In 2017 I helped facilitate a local growth effort for K9's for Warriors which provides service dogs to Veterans living with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder.
