

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, upon the recommendation of Commissioner Kitty Jung for District 3, has determined that \$8,400.00 will be granted to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, Patrol Division -- a government entity -- for the purpose of purchasing a Stalker Rotatable Speed Alert Monitor (SAM-R) Trailer to be utilized along Sun Valley Boulevard and, subsequently, any areas within Washoe County; and

**WHEREAS**, This device includes a rotating speed display to visually display drivers' real-time speeds compared to the speed limit, which can be effective in reducing speeds and increasing awareness of local speed limits; and

**WHEREAS**, The collection of traffic statistics and data will allow the Sheriff's Office to deploy patrol officers more effectively to deal with speed issues; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, Patrol Division, a grant for fiscal year 2021-2022 in the amount of \$8,400.00
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by meeting the needs of our growing community.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
