SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept a grant award amendment increasing the funding by [\$20,000 to a new total award amount of \$117,603 with no county match] from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services for toxicology expenses relating to the Overdose to Action (OD2A) program, retroactive from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022, and authorize the Chief Medical Examiner & Coroner of the Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office to sign the award, and direct the Comptroller's Department to make the necessary budget amendments. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

This grant allows for paid staff time (including fringe and benefits), operating, travel, and toxicology expenses to investigate drug-related deaths and input data into the Overdose to Action (OD2A) system. This is the third year the Regional Medical Examiner's Office has received this grant. The original award is being amended to include an additional \$20,000 for toxicology expenses.

BACKGROUND

The original grant award is being amended with an additional \$20,000 for toxicology expenses. The funding is retroactive to September 1, 2021.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: Overdose to Action (OD2A)

Scope of the Project: Provides for personnel, operating, expanded toxicology testing, and travel expenses to investigate drug-related deaths and receive training for such investigations

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: This program creates a detailed data repository for drug-related deaths with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This data can be used by law enforcement, health agencies, etc. to better understand the root causes of such deaths which will lead to better prevention and treatment programs.

On-Going Program Support: This is the third year of the program created by the federal government and will continue as long as grant funding is available.

FISCAL IMPACT

Expenses for this grant will be reimbursed to Washoe County from the State of Nevada after they are incurred. The Regional Medical Examiner's Office has sufficient budget to pay the expenses until reimbursement occurs. No match is required for this grant. Indirect costs are not allowable on this grant award as no salary or wages are included in the grant budget. Should the board accept this grant award amendment, the Fiscal Year 2022 adopted budget for the Regional Medical Examiner's Office will be increased by \$20,000.00 in both revenues and expenditures in the following accounts:
