SUMMARY

The Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) offered the donation of military surplus equipment to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office to be utilized to support the Honor Guard. This equipment was obtained at no charge to the county from the military.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Board of County Commissioners has accepted DRMO donations for the Sheriff's Office yearly with the last acceptances being June 20, 2017, May 17, 2016, November 15, 2016, June 16, 2015, and June 24, 2014.
