SUMMARY

The Juvenile Justice Program Office provides funding to assist with the treatment and programming needs of Washoe County youth under the supervision of Washoe County Department of Juvenile Services.

County Priority/Goal supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On June 27, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the Community Corrections Partnership Block Grant from the Department of Health and Human Services Juvenile Justice Programs Office in the amount of \$322,462.22 to provide treatment and programming to youth referred to the Washoe County Department of Juvenile Services.

On June 28, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the Community Corrections Partnership Block Grant from the Department of Health and Human Services Juvenile Justice Programs Office in the amount of \$328,790.28.

On July 14, 2015, the Board of County Commissioners accepted Specialized Foster Care Room and Board Funding from the Department of Health and Human Services – Juvenile Justice Programs Office in the amount of \$350,714.58.

This funding was formally granted as the Specialized Foster Care Room and Board Medicaid Funding.
