

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Kitty Jung for District 3, has determined that [\$5,000.00] will be granted to Washoe County Community Services Department, Regional Parks and Open Space -- a government entity -- for the purpose of supporting the professional production of a 20-minute mini-documentary video highlighting Rancho San Rafael's 40-year history;

**WHEREAS**, This professional video would be displayed June 01 through June 30 in the Wilbur D. May Museum during the "Rancho San Rafael Past, Present, and Future" exhibit, and thereafter, the video would reside permanently in the Rancho San Rafael Visitor Center on a continual loop for park visitors; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Washoe County Community Services Department, Regional Parks and Open Space, a grant for fiscal year 2021-2022 in the amount of \$5,000.00
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by strengthening our culture of service and instilling pride in the community.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
