from various businesses, organizations and individuals for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments. (All Commission

SUMMARY

Accept a total of \$9,268.30 in cash and estimated value of \$42,707 in-kind donations from various businesses, organizations and individuals for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Stewardship of our Community.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are frequently made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners (Board).

BACKGROUND

The citizens of Washoe County continue to support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous donations of time, materials, services and cash. Cash [\$9,268.30] and in-kind [estimated value \$42,707] donations have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort of our citizens.

Cash donations received are dedicated to the Lazy 5 Regional Park summer music concert, Bartley Ranch Regional Park program, May museum marketing and programming support, and the May Arboretum garden maintenance and improvements.

The in-kind donations received include two gas powered mobile spray tanks and garden and landscape renovation valued at \$40,677 from the May Arboretum Society.

Other in-kind donations include paint and supplies for the Lazy 5 Sand Dome building from the Reno Paint Mart and Kelly Moore Paint Company and gift cards for the Lazy 5 Regional Park music series concert from various donors.

Thank you and recognition is extended to all the donors for their continued support of natural and cultural resource management and community programming.

The donations enable Regional Parks and Open Space to offer programming or assist in repairing, replacing or maintaining facilities and items that are not supported by appropriations elsewhere, and to support volunteer efforts with no impact to the general fund.
