

#### Welfare of the Inmates


- Creating a Detention Services Unit (DSU)
  - Combines all inmate focus services within same office including Admin Support Unit, Inmate Assistance Program, NV Health and Human Services, Discharge Planning
  - Re-establish inmate diversion programs such as House Arrest and Sheriff's Community Work Program
- Creating Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program to include a Narcotics Treatment Program (NTP)
  - ▶ NTP will consist of protocols for treating inmates with opioid, alcohol, and other withdrawal symptoms and continuing care for those inmates already accepting treatment
  - MAT program will also offer long acting medication treatments such as Vivitrol

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
- ▶ Jail continues to see increase in arrestees with mental illness, homelessness, and drug addiction
  - ► Increased partnerships with local providers
  - Partnership with Volunteers of America and Reno Ambassadors
    - ► Karma Box
  - ► New partnership with Renown Regional Medical Center
  - Creation of a Release Services Desk in jail lobby
- ► The goal is to ensure we are providing all services needed to allow inmates to transition into a better life and reduce recidivism

# **Booking Data**


- ▶ 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Booking Data is trending down compared to last quarter and last fiscal year

# Inmate Bookings by Calendar Year





# **Inmate Bookings by Agency**



### Inmate Average Daily Population


- ► Typically population trends down during Winter months based on weather
- ► This quarter saw an ADP in March of 1121, an increase over the historical average for 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter and trending up for the fiscal year





## Inmate Booking Types

- Types of inmates booked and housed remain flat from prior reports
- No significant trends relative to the types of arrestees
- Average length of stay has not changed significantly
