SUMMARY

Washoe County Regional Animal Services has been the recipient of cash donations totaling \$10,991.30 donated for the use of the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at risk animals received.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Other prior donations, independent of this item, have been accepted on behalf of Washoe County Regional Animal Services.

BACKGROUND

For the period of January 1, 2018 to March 31, 2018, Washoe County Regional Animal Services was the recipient of cash donations totaling \$10,991.30. (Reference attached list).

Donations are generally used to encourage responsible pet ownership, seek treatment of sick or injured animals, or at risk animals, and to promote humane treatment of animals.

FISCAL IMPACT

Upon receipt, monetary donations are deposited into a special Internal Order for donations, IN 20319-484000 (Injured Animal Fund-Donations). The budget amendment will occur in FY 17/18 in the following revenue and expenditure accounts:
