SUMMARY

Accept cash donations in the amount of \$32,923.92 and in-kind donations estimated value of \$19,773.60 from various businesses, organizations and individuals for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

BACKGROUND

The residents of Washoe County support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous cash contributions, donations of materials, supplies and services and volunteer time. Cash donations, in the amount of \$32,923.92, and in-kind donation at an estimated value of \$19,773.60 have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort for Washoe County residents.

Cash donations received are dedicated to the operations and maintenance support for the Lazy 5 Park The Hive, Bowers Mansion, Bartley Ranch Park, Rancho San Rafael Park, May Museum for marketing and programming and for May Arboretum garden memorial brick(s), adopt a tree, tree pruning, maintenance, improvements and Historic Huffaker School House.
