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SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept a 2023 Nevada State Emergency Response

Commission (SERC), United We Stand (UWS) grant for [\$31,887.00, no County match required]. The UWS grant is intended to improve state and local government planning, training, and response capabilities to react to Acts of Terrorism. Grant Term is retroactive to July 14, 2022, through June 30, 2023. If approved, authorize the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) Chair to execute grant documents and authorize the County Manager or his designee, to sign the Washoe County Sub-Grant Agreements between Washoe County and the Regional Emergency Medical Service Authority (REMSA), per NRS 244.1505 in the amount of [\$14,900.00] for twenty (20) ballistic vests; and Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (TMFPD), per NRS 244.1505, in the amount of [\$16,987.00] for sixteen (16) cyanokits: approve Resolution necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments. # **SUMMARY**

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is requested to accept a 2023 Nevada State Emergency Response Commission, UWS grant for [\$31,877.00, no County match required] from the State of Nevada SERC. The Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) will utilize and subgrant these funds to member entities to provide equipment to local first responders and first receivers. Equipment will allow local first responders be better prepared to effectively respond to acts of terrorism within the region.

Staff is requesting a retroactive approval to July 14, 2022, due to timing of new fiscal year and timing of BCC meeting opportunities.

**Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item:** Economic Impacts Support a thriving community.

#### PREVIOUS ACTION

**August 17, 2021** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2022 SERC UWS grant for \$32,000.00.

**August 31, 2020** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2021 SERC UWS grant for \$32,000.00.

**February 25, 2020** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2020 SERC UWS grant for \$30,000.00.

**September 11, 2018** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2019 SERC UWS grant for \$25,000.00.

October 24, 2017 – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2018 SERC UWS grant for \$24,920.00.

**August 9, 2016** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2017 SERC UWS grant for \$24,887.00.

**August 12, 2014** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2015 SERC UWS Grant for \$30,000.00.

The BCC has accepted this award annually for 15 of the past 16 years.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The source of this funding is derived from fees collected from the sale and annual renewal of the United We Stand specialty license plates. The grant provides funding to the Washoe County Local Emergency Planning Committee for Planning, Training and Equipment purchases. The grant funding intent is to improve state and local government planning, training, and response capabilities to react to Acts of Terrorism.
