WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Bob Lucey for District 2, has determined that \$3,000 will be granted to the Friends of Washoe County Library to support the South Valleys Library's STEAM related programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of Washoe County Library is a non-profit organization dedicated to advocating, fundraising, and providing support for Washoe County Library System; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Washoe County Library System is to connect people with information, ideas and experiences to support an enriched and engaged community, one person at a time; and

WHEREAS, the Washoe County Library System, including the South Valleys Library branch, offer programs that involve STEAM--Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math--for kids, teens, and adults; and

WHEREAS, Governments across the world agree that for countries to thrive in today's knowledge-based economy, their workforces need a strong STEAM skills base; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to the Friends of Washoe County Library, a grant for fiscal year 2017-2018 in the amount of \$3,000.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by supporting the South Valleys Library's STEAM related programs and services.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase of tickets to special events.
