BACKGROUND

Washoe County Department of Juvenile Services will be purchasing a full-body scanner for our booking intake area to screen all juveniles being admitted to the secure detention area of our facility. This scanner will increase the safety and security of our facility by increasing our ability to identify contraband items prior to admission into the detention facility. This equipment will also significantly reduce the need for visual skin searches of juveniles, which can be traumatic for youth. The use of a sole source for the purchase of this equipment has been approved by both Purchasing and the District Attorney.

FISCAL IMPACT

Juvenile Services has sufficient budget authority in the FY22 Services and Supply budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation to approve the sole source purchase of the Clearpass Full-Body Security Screening System [\$164,357.12] from Adani Systems, Inc., to screen juveniles for contraband and weapons as they are admitted to the secure detection section of Jan Evans Juvenile Justice Center.
