SUMMARY

Washoe County Regional Animal Services has been the recipient of donations totaling \$10,621.84 donated for the use of the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at-risk animals received.

BACKGROUND

For the period of October 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019, Washoe County Regional Animal Services was the recipient of donations totaling \$10,621.84. (Reference attached list).

Donations are generally used to encourage responsible pet ownership, seek treatment of sick or injured animals, or at-risk animals, and to promote humane treatment of animals.
