

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes.

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to the Tahoe Fund for the purpose of supporting the ongoing sustainable tourism initiative, Take Care Tahoe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tahoe Fund’s mission is to utilize the power of philanthropy to improve the Lake Tahoe environment for all to enjoy and to educate the general public on the environmental issues facing restoration efforts at Lake Tahoe and to raising funds to support Environmental Improvement Program (EIP) projects that restore and enhance the natural environment; and

**WHEREAS**, this agency envisions a Lake Tahoe where the natural and human environments are in balance and a growing community of passionate supporters enjoy and cherish this mountain treasure; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Tahoe Fund a grant for the purpose of supporting a billboard campaign highlighting issues that advocate for the preservation of the Lake Tahoe Basin, a grant for fiscal year 2022-2023 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents surrounding Lake Tahoe by educating the general public on the environmental issues facing restoration efforts at Lake Tahoe and raising funds to support Environmental Improvement Program (EIP) projects that restore and enhance the natural environment.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
