

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

The Washoe County Commission, during their regularly scheduled business meeting of December 18, 2018 at 10:00 AM, will consider water rights applications 88248, filed on August 22, 2018 by The University of Nevada, Reno Foundation, and application 88249 filed on August 22, 2018 by The Glenbrook Company, a Nevada Corporation. Both applications are on file in the office of the Nevada State Engineer. The existing manner of use for both applications is irrigation, stock water and domestic use and the proposed manner of use for both applications is for Municipal use. These applications propose to change the points of diversion and places of use of Lake Tahoe (via Glenbrook Creek) water rights previously diverted and placed to use in Douglas County to points of diversion and places of use within Washoe County. The meeting will take place in the Commissioners Chambers, Washoe County Administration Building, 1001 East Ninth Street, Reno, Nevada. Anyone wishing to appear may do so at the above-named time and place and present written and oral comments.
