




RTC Background

The Regional Transportation Commission of Washoe County (RTC) is the federally-recognized Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Truckee Meadows. RTC is responsible for:

- Transportation planning as a condition of Federal aid
- Managing transportation revenue
- Provides regional transit service





Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Overview

The purpose of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is to:



Identify the transportation projects, programs and services that may be implemented through 2050



Functions as the major tool for implementing long-range transportation planning



Captures the community's vision for the transportation system



Establishes an implementation plan to achieve that vision



RTP Update Overview


RTPs are updated every five (5) years to account for the latest conditions and reflect the community's current priorities.
