Authorizing grant of funds to City of Reno

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the American Rescue Plan Act funds through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, Assistance Listing #21.027, passed through to City of Reno for the interlocal agreement for the Truckee River Master Plan contract to Dig Studio will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno's legal status is a governmental entity

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

- 1. City of Reno, a grant in the amount of \$100,000
- 2. The purpose of the SLFRF-ARPA funded program is to provide an implementation guide for enhancing the economic, safety, and sustainability opportunities on the Truckee River.
- 3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement that will be signed by the County Manager.
