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



## Extreme Heat (RS:62)


### **Historical Events**

  - Washoe Regional Emergency Information Center

#### LEVELS OF ACTIVATION

#### Level I

#### **Full Activation**

The REOC is fully staffed with all personnel and representative. Local Emergency declaration and Presidential Disaster Declaration may be requested

#### Level II

#### **Partial Activation**

The EOC may be activated on a limited or partial basis. Limited response activities.

#### Level III


#### **Monitor and Assess**

Minimal staff involvement, typically handled by Emergency Management personnel for situational awareness






CDC ESSENCE/ NSSP





- Enhanced Training Expand POD & Mass Casualty Incident exercises with climate disaster scenarios
  - Earthquake workshop and exercise (May 2025)
- Community Outreach Urban heat island mapping and cooling centers for vulnerable populations
- Infrastructure Investments Urban wildland fire prevention efforts
  - Defensible space inspections for high-risk areas
  - Curbside yard debris recycling
  - Ongoing fuel reduction projects
