<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$2,500.00 will be granted to Seniors in Service to support the mission of engaging vibrant and experienced volunteers to enrich Northern Nevada communities one life at a time; and

WHEREAS, Seniors in Service partners with programs such as Foster Grandparents, Senior Companions, and the Respite Voucher Program, all of which promote meaningful volunteerism and intergenerational service; and

WHEREAS, Seniors in Service provides opportunities for senior citizens to volunteer in their community, thereby improving the quality of life for both the volunteer and those they serve; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to Seniors in Service a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 to in the amount of \$2,500.00.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.

4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
