PREVIOUS ACTION

On April 23, 2026, the District Health Officer executed this amended subaward in the total amount of \$20,654 for the period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

This Award supports the Population Health (PHD) Division's mission to strengthen the capacity of public health infrastructure to detect, assess, and respond decisively to control the public health consequences of bioterrorism events or any public health emergency.

The Subaward provides funding for office supplies, operating and training.
