

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$2,850.00 will be granted to MidTown Reno Foundation, to support MidTown Snowflake Help; and

WHEREAS, MidTown Reno Foundation mission is to support local business through beautification projects and community engagement programs; and

WHEREAS, MidTown Reno Foundation fosters community through public art installations, infrastructure improvements, and support for neighborhood events and initiatives; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to MidTown Reno Foundation, a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$2,850.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
