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SUBJECT: Approve a Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada Department of Health and

Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026 in the total amount of \$116,216.00 (no required match) in support of the Community and Clinical Health Services (CCHS) Division Fetal Infant Mortality Review (FIMR) Program and authorize the District Health

Officer to execute the Subaward and any future amendments.

SUMMARY

The Community and Clinical Health Services Division received a Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health on November 25, 2025 to support the Fetal Infant Mortality Review (FIMR) Program. The funding period is October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026. A copy of the Notice of Subaward is attached.

District Health Strategic Priority supported by this item:

1. Healthy Lives: Improve the health of our community by empowering individuals to live healthier lives.

PREVIOUS ACTION

There has been no previous action taken by the Board this fiscal year.

BACKGROUND

This Award supports the Fetal Infant Mortality Review (FIMR) Program which looks at a variety of factors that affect the health of the mother, fetus and infant to learn more about how to reduce fetal and infant mortality. The program will develop a periodic local summary report of findings and recommendations that address the identified contributing factors leading to fetal and infant deaths.

The Subaward provides funding for personnel, travel, operating and indirect expenditures.

This item is retroactive due to the Notice of Subaward being issued on November 28, 2025, and is being brought for approval at the nearest scheduled District Board of Health meeting.

Subject: FY26 CCHS FIMR Program

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FISCAL IMPACT

The District anticipated this award and included funding in the adopted FY26 budget. A budget adjustment in the amount of \$56,488.04 (\$5,134.87 indirect expenses) will be made to move the authority from IO 12432 to the new IO 12615.

Should the Board approve this subaward, a request will be made to the Board of County Commissioners to amend the adopted FY26 budget, increasing it by \$49,702.83 in the following accounts to match the notice of subaward:
