

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Agency.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$10,000.00 will be granted to Washoe County Human Services Agency (HSA) to support the Northern Nevada Literacy Council (NNLC) Cares Campus project to provide classes supporting literacy, adult basic education and workforce readiness in a quality learning environment; and

WHEREAS, HSA in conjunction with NNLC will coordinate to deliver these educational programs designed to enhance literacy, employability, and self-sufficiency among adult learners in Washoe County; and

WHEREAS, NNLC's literacy initiatives result in educated adults and families who contribute to a more stable and economically healthy workforce, thereby strengthening the overall well-being of the community; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to Washoe County Human Services Agency, a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$10,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
