SUMMARY

This award will fund a contractor to supplement the court's IT team in the implementation and data migration of the existing Case Management System (CMS) into a new, modern CMS which will improve efficiency in case processing and support electronic access.

PREVIOUS ACTION

No previous Board action.

BACKGROUND

The Second Judicial District Court is currently using an outdated and unsupported CMS which was implemented in 1998. Working with the Nevada Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), a new vendor was selected through an RFP process and the Court has been taking the necessary steps towards implementation and transition since 2023. The system is scheduled to go live September 2025 and the next several months will be very time and staff intensive.
