

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity and a Quasi-Municipal Corporation

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$10,000.00 will be granted to the Palomino Valley General Improvement District (PVGID), for the purpose of improving and maintaining the roads managed by the organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the Palomino Valley General Improvement District is a government entity and a quasi-municipal corporation responsible for maintaining 92.8 miles of road using PVGID-owned equipment and employees ; therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Palomino Valley General Improvement District, a grant for fiscal year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$10,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
3. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution’s approval.
4. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
