

RESOLUTION: R24-95

Authorizing grant of funds to Nevada Humane Society

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the ARPA fund passed through to Nevada Humane Society to support the operation of a public high-volume, high-quality spay/neuter program

WHEREAS, Nevada Humane Society legal status is as a nonprofit corporation created for educational or charitable purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

1. Nevada Humane Society, a grant in the amount of \$750,000.00.
2. The purpose of the SLFRF- ARPA funded program is Community Spay & Neuter Project, to support the operation of a public high-volume, high-quality spay/neuter program at the Nevada Humane Society (NHS). This funding will support a program aiming to perform 5,000 surgeries within the first 12 months of operation and grow to 7,000 surgeries the following year.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement that will be signed by the County Manager.
