

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Marsha Berkbigler for District 1, has determined that \$15,000 is needed for the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District to support education efforts and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) assistance; and,

WHEREAS, The mission of the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District is to promote the conservation and improvement of the Lake Tahoe Basin's natural resources by providing leadership, education, and technical assistance to all basin users; and,

WHEREAS, the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District is a non-regulatory and grant funded local government agency in Nevada that works closely with its Federal, State, and Local partners to deliver conservation programs to the Nevada Lake Tahoe Community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District, a Government Entity, a grant for fiscal year 2018-2019 in the amount of \$15,000.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants for the County by supporting the conservation and improvement of the Lake Tahoe Basin's natural resources.
3. Funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
