

**RESOLUTION** – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to North Valleys High School – a government entity – to support the North Valleys High School JROTC program; and

**WHEREAS**, North Valleys High School JROTC’s has the core value of “Integrity First, Service Before Self and Excellence in All We Do” continuing the tradition of giving back to the community and community organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, North Valleys High School JROTC battalion “the Panther Air Wing” first established in the 2024-2025 school year; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to North Valleys High School, a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by providing area youth personal and leadership opportunities that will impact them as future leaders throughout their lifetimes.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution’s approval.
