SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve and adopt Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District

Resolutions TM07-2025 to amend the District's Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget for the General Fund and Emergency Fund in the amount of \$200,000 and TM08-2025 to amend the District's Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget for the Emergency Medical Services fund in the amount of \$50,755 and if approved direct the District to make the appropriate budget adjustments. SUMMARY

Recommendation to approve and adopt Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Resolutions TM07-2025 to amend the District's Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (FY24/25) Budget for the General Fund and Emergency Fund in the amount of \$200,000 and TM08-2025 to amend the District's Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (FY24/25) Budget for the Emergency Medical Services fund in the amount of \$50,755 and if approved direct the District to make the appropriate budget adjustments.

PREVIOUS ACTION

May 21, 2024, the Board of Fire Commissioners approved the District's FY24/25 tentative budget with changes to be adopted into the Final Budget as presented.

May 6, 2025, the Board of Fire Commissioners accepted a grant award from the State of Nevada's Division of Public and Behavioral Health in the amount of \$6,313.73 for the purchase of a training skin for our cut suit. The cut suit is used in trauma scenarios that may occur during emergency medical services calls.

May 6, 2025, the Board of Fire Commissioners accepted a grant award from the State Emergency Response Commission in the amount of \$5,317.30 for the purchase of tox medic medications that may be used during hazmat or emergency medical services calls.

May 20, 2025, the Board of Fire Commissioners approved the District's Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (FY25/26) tentative budget with changes to be adopted into the Final Budget. The FY25/26 budget included estimated actual for FY24/25, which included these amendments.

June 3, 2025, the Board of Fire Commissioners is being asked to accept a donation of two (2) Lucas 3 Mechanical Compression Devices and accessories, including any required carrying cases and corresponding supplies from the Inter-Hospital Coordinating Council, and express sincere appreciation for the thoughtful contribution.

BACKGROUND

The District has revenues generated from previously unbudgeted sources. These sources have been previously approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners under grants, agreements, donations, and debt proceeds. In addition, the District has the need to use a portion of contingency to support the Emergency Fund due to extraordinary in-District fires during FY24/25.

The additional sources and uses are listed below:

EMS Fund:

The Board has accepted, or is anticipated to accept, the following grants and donations for a total value of \$50,755.

- 1. State Grant for the purchase of a training skin for the District's cut suit in the amount of \$6,314.
- 2. State Grant for the purchase of tox medic medications that may be used during hazmat or emergency medical services calls in the amount of \$5,317.
- 3. Donation of Lucas CPR devices and Accessories of \$39,124.

If approved, the amendments and augmentations will result in an increase in appropriations for the Emergency Fund by \$200,000, the reallocation of contingency funds in the General Fund of \$200,000, and an increase in appropriations for the EMS Fund by \$50,755.
