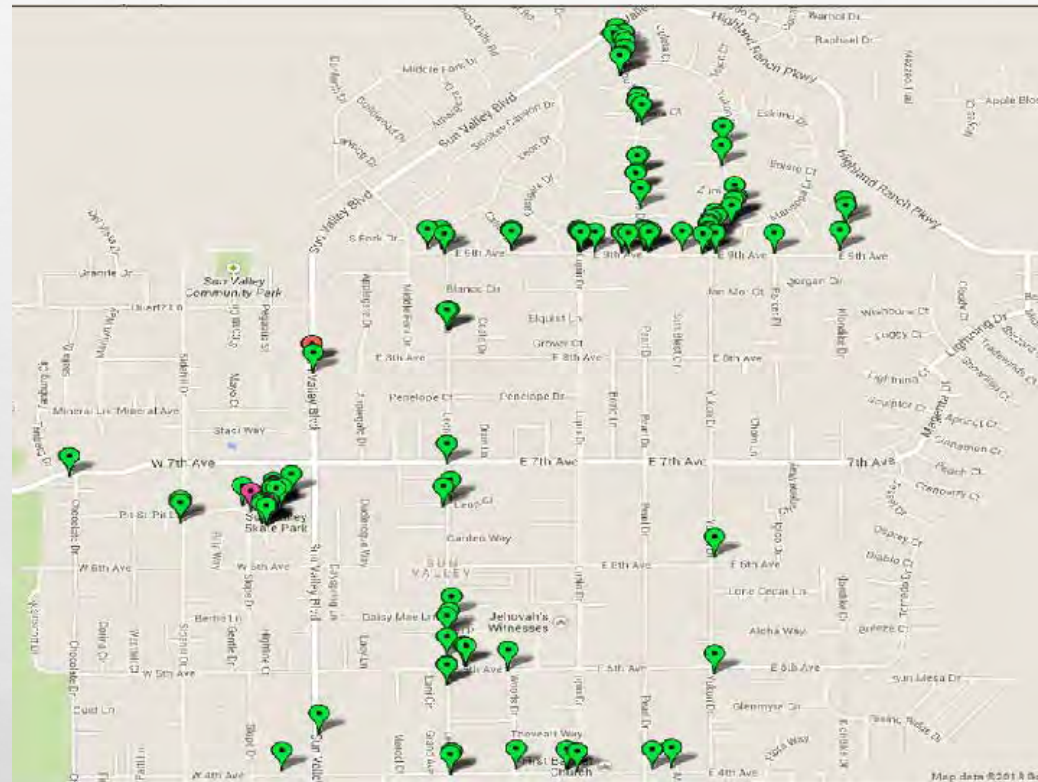

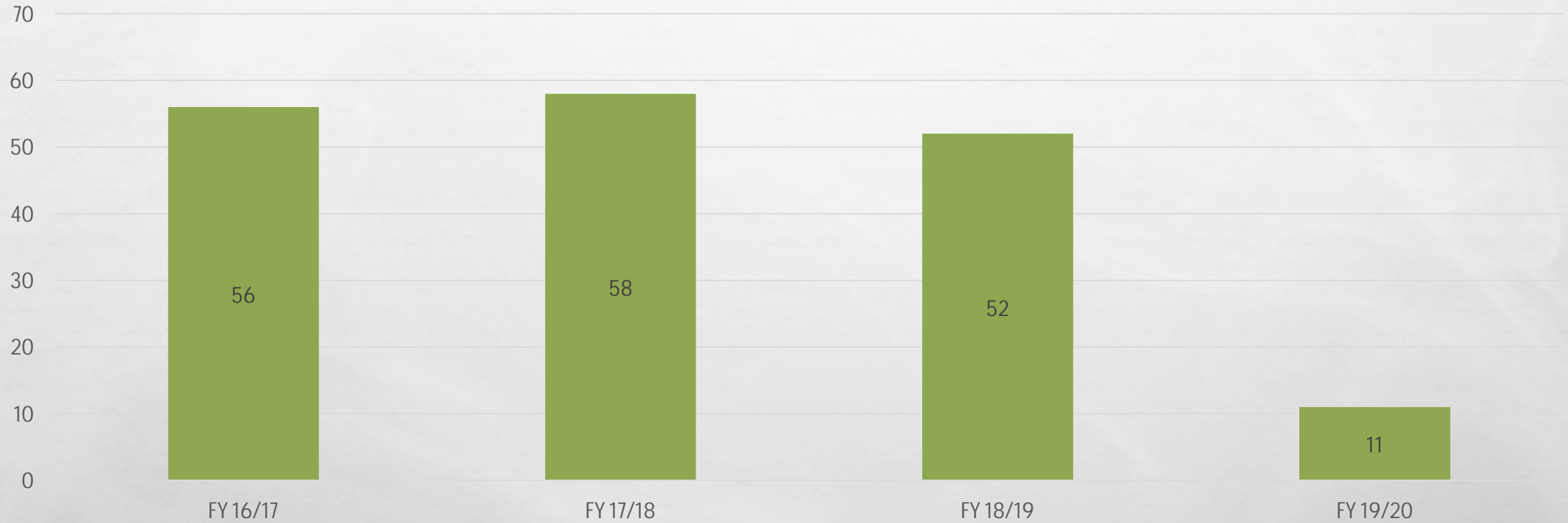

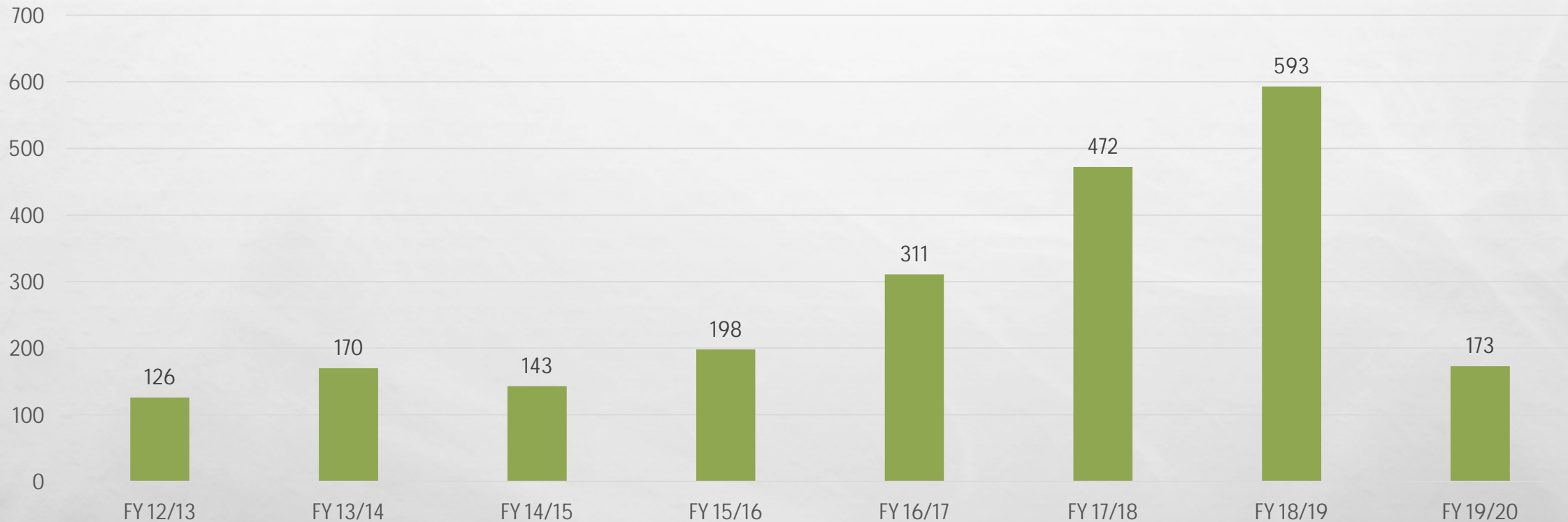

CONTRIBUTING FACTORS / CHALLENGES

- SCRAP METAL PRICING
 - DUE TO THE DECREASE IN SCRAP METAL PRICING, A VEHICLE THAT USED TO NET \$400-\$600 NOW ONLY BRINGS IN ABOUT \$50-125.
- COST AND CONVENIENCE OF LEGITIMATE DISPOSAL
- DMV REGISTRATION AND LICENSING PROCEDURES
- BURDEN ON LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
- BURDEN ON LOCAL TOW COMPANIES AND THEIR STORAGE CAPACITY
- REMOVING VEHICLES IN A TIMELY MANNER

ISSUES WITH ABANDONED VEHICLES

- MAJOR QUALITY-OF-LIFE FOR RESIDENTS OF WASHOE COUNTY
 - BROKEN WINDOWS THEORY
- VEHICLES CONTAIN GASOLINE AND OTHER DANGEROUS FLUIDS
- ATTRACT FURTHER DAMAGE AND PARTS-STRIPPING
- ATTRACT CHILDREN TO PLAY IN OR AROUND
- DUMPED VEHICLES ATTRACT MORE VEHICLES



CURRENT COLLABORATION

- WCSO HAS BEEN HOLDING QUARTERLY MEETINGS WITH COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS IN AN ATTEMPT TO UNDERSTAND THIS PHENOMENON AND FIND SOLUTIONS. TWO MEETINGS HAVE BEEN WELL ATTENDED SO FAR ON 04/25/2019 AND 08/01/2019.
