<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$2,500.00 will be granted to the India Association of Northern Nevada, to support scholarship program for children in the community; and

WHEREAS, the India Association of Northern Nevada is a nonprofit organization that was founded in 1980's, to create a positive and enjoyable environment to nurture friendships and celebrate festivals; and

WHEREAS, the India association of Northern Nevada strives to celebrate the diversity and rich heritage of the Indian sub-continent by organizing cultural events and supporting local communities; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to the India Association of Northern Nevada, a grant for fiscal year 2024-2025 in the amount of \$2,500.00.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.

4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
