

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Kitty Jung for District 3, has determined that \$20,000 will be granted to Sun Valley General Improvement District to support the replacement of three sets of double doors at the Sun Valley Neighborhood Center; and

WHEREAS, Sun Valley General Improvement District is a quasi-municipality that oversees the distribution of safe drinking water, wastewater collection, garbage collection and recreation to the majority of the Sun Valley community; and

WHEREAS, the Sun Valley Neighborhood Center is used as a Washoe County Senior Program site, hub station for Washoe County Sheriff's Office, as well as a facility to host various public meetings and other community events; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to Sun Valley General Improvement District, a grant for fiscal year 2021-2022 in the amount of \$20,000.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by supporting Sun Valley General Improvement District in replacing three sets of double doors at the Sun Valley Neighborhood Center.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
