SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept a Nevada Division of Emergency Management grant award [amount not to exceed \$190,160.00, no County match required] as administered through the State of Nevada, Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management, Federal FY 2019 project number 19-3000, to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Bomb Unit for the purchase of equipment for the Consolidated Bomb Team for the retroactive grant term of September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2021 and if approved, authorize Sheriff Balaam to execute grant award documentation, and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments. (All Commission Districts)

SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval to accept the grant award from the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management, through the Department of Homeland Security. Per county policy, the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners must accept grant awards and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments.

The Nevada Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management, Homeland Security has awarded the Washoe County Sheriff's Office funding for the purchase of Air Purifying Respirators (APR) and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) equipment for the Consolidated Bomb Squad. The Air Purifying Respirators and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus will allow our Bomb Squad Unit to safely respond and assist in rescue efforts involving hazardous chemicals in our community.

December 11, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved item # 7.G.6, the Sheriff's Office request to accept [\$100,636.00, no match required] from the Nevada Division of Emergency Management, Federal FY 2018 to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Bomb Unit for the purchase of equipment for the retroactive grant term of September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2020.

November 14, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved item # 5.G.2, the Sheriff's Office request to accept [\$18,703.00, no match required] from the Nevada Division of Emergency Management, Federal FY 2017 to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Bomb Unit for the purchase of equipment for the retroactive grant term of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2019.

BACKGROUND

On October 1, 2019, the Washoe County Sheriff's Office received notification it had been awarded a grant from the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management for the purchase of Air Purifying Respirators and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus for their Consolidated Bomb Squad. The Bomb Squad provides emergency response and mitigation to incidents that are suspected to be explosive in nature and/or are affiliated with biological or chemical substances. The Air Purifying Respirators and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus will allow our Bomb Squad Unit to safely respond and assist in rescue efforts involving hazardous chemicals in our community.

Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once paperwork was received and processed.
