Authorizing grant of funds to Be Who You Needed

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the American Rescue Plan Act funds through the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, Assistance Listing #21.027, passed through to Be Who You Needed for the Emergency Eviction Prevention program which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

WHEREAS, Be Who You Needed's legal status is as a nonprofit corporation created for educational or charitable purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

- 1. Be Who You Needed, a grant in the amount of \$200,000.
- 2. The purpose of the funded program is to support 300-320 households at risk of homelessness over the next 12 months through housing stabilization advisory and resource navigation, preservation of rental history, and preservation of relationships between landlords and tenants.
- 3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement that will be signed by the County Manager.
