

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$2,500.00 will be granted to the Incline Village Crystal Bay Community & Business Association to utilize for event expenses associated with the Local Heroes Celebration and IVCB Sky Show; and

WHEREAS, the IVCBA is a local community and business association dedicated to building and growing cohesiveness for the sustainability of Incline Village and Crystal Bay; and

WHEREAS, this agency builds community awareness through organizing events and promoting businesses and nonprofits throughout the year and invites community collaborators to assist in developing synergy and a positive identity to Incline Village/Crystal Bay communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Incline Village Crystal Bay Community & Business Association a grant to utilize for event expenses associated with the Local Heroes Celebration and IVCB Sky Show, a grant for fiscal year 2022-2023 in the amount of \$2,500.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents surrounding Lake Tahoe by building and growing cohesiveness for the sustainability of Incline Village and Crystal Bay.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
