Good morning. Our owner would like to pursue a meeting with the board to review the permit fee charged for Pool permit BLD24-00149E. As discussed, we feel we should have been charged the rate in effect when the permit was submitted originally on 7/7/2023 and not the fee imposed after the rate change on 7/1/2024. Regardless of timeline and the delays that transpired during plan review, waiting for responses and waiting for clarifications on provided comments, our main concern is that the final comments that were ultimately approved were submitted 6/12/2024. We believe that the small amount of information that was resubmitted could have been approved in the 12 business days before the new rates took effect, saving our owner this added cost. Please let us know if you require additional detail in order to present this to the board.
