SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept additional fiscal year 2026 U.S. Forest Service grant award funding [increased amount not to exceed \$3,000.00, for a total of \$13,000.00, no County match required] as administered from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, federal project number 26-LE-11041700-017, for patrol of U.S. Forest Service designated roads, campgrounds, developed sites, or dispersed areas for the retroactive grant period of February 13, 2026 through January 31, 2031; authorize the Sheriff to retroactively execute the award document; and direct Finance to make the necessary budget amendments. SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval to accept additional funding for the grant award from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest (Modification 001 of grant agreement 26-LE-11041700-017).

Per County policy, the Washoe Board of County Commissioners must accept grant awards and must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct Finance to make the necessary budget amendments.

These funds from the USDA Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest will be used to reimburse Washoe County Sheriff's Office for overtime costs incurred while involved in the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement #26-LE-11041700-017.

On June 20, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners approved Item 8.I.2., an additional \$13,000.00 of U.S. Forest Service funding as administered through the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest for overtime costs incurred while involved in the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement #21-LE-11041700-005.

On March 8, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners approved Item 5.G.1., an additional \$13,000.00 of U.S. Forest Service funding as administered through the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest for overtime costs incurred while involved in the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement #21-LE-11041700-005.

On September 14, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners approved Item 6.G.1., an additional \$13,600.00 of U.S. Forest Service funding as administered through the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest for overtime costs incurred while involved in the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement #21-LE-11041700-005.

The Board has been approving funding for agreements between the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the USDA Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest since 2016.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office is a cooperator with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest. Funds are allocated to cover overtime costs incurred while involved in the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement. During peak season of Memorial Day to Labor Day, Washoe County Sheriff's Office deputies patrol U.S. Forest Service designated roads, campgrounds, developed sites, and dispersed areas periodically. Time associated with these patrols will be reimbursed.

Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once documents were received and processed.
