SUMMARY

The Washoe Board of County Commissioners must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 28, 2023 the District Board of Health approved the Notice of Subaward from the State of Nevada, Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public & Behavioral Health in the total amount of \$26,573 for the period July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

BACKGROUND

This award supports the Epidemiology and Public Health Preparedness Program by providing funding to purchase a Lucas device to support healthcare preparedness ability to respond when otherwise not safe for emergency responders.

FISCAL IMPACT

Should the Board approve these amendments, the Health Fund (202) FY24 adopted budget will be increased by \$24,092.00 in both revenues and expenditures in the following accounts:
