Highlight of Legislation

- **AB70**: Revises provisions governing the Open Meeting Law.
- **AB102**: Enhances the criminal penalty for certain crimes committed against certain family members of first responders.
- **AB240**: Requires representatives from certain counties to meet jointly and prepare reports addressing the orderly management of growth in their region.
- **AB301**: Revises provisions relating to jails.



80th Legislative Session Report

Highlight of Legislation

- **SB12**: Revises provisions governing telephone systems used for reporting emergencies.
- **SB103**: Revises provisions relating to development and maintenance of affordable housing.
- **SB279**: Revises provisions relating to general improvement districts.



80th Legislative Session Report

Highlight of Legislation

- **SB245**: Revises provisions relating to civil actions.
- **SB287**: Revises provisions governing public records.



Bills that require commission action

- **AB81-** nominations have been sent to the Governor for the newly created Board of Indigent Defense Services.
- **AB272-** in process for the board to designate a forensic laboratory to conduct certain duties related to ballistic testing.
- **SB89-** in process for the board to make changes to county code 65 to reflect the necessary changes related to creating a non-voting member of the Emergency 911 Advisory Committee and allowing funding to both school district police as well as alternative sentencing for body worn cameras.
- **AB236-** by July 1, 2020 the board will need to appoint 2 members to the Nevada Local Justice Reinvestment Coordinating Council.
