This justification supports the Sole Source procurement of services from Naphcare to continue and expand its current role in providing Mental Health services. This includes the escalation of the current treatment program in order to encompass full competency restoration services for incarcerated individuals deemed incompetent to stand trial.

With the passing of Assembly Bill 467 Washoe County is expanding the Jail Based Mental Health Unit's existing programs to include in house competency restoration services. This will allow the jail to restore individuals to trial competency on-site, significantly reducing the burden on the state and expediting the legal process.

Unique features /qualifications required that are not available from another supplier.

Napchcare has been contracted with Washoe County for some time, and has been directly involved with the Mental Health Unit since it's inception. Naphcare staff are already trained, credentialed, and embedded within the facility, reducing start up time and potential lapse in care.

Were other options sought? If yes, why were they unacceptable? If no, why were no alternatives reviewed?

No. Utilizing Naphcare for competency restoration and Mental Health treatment leverages existing contracts, avoiding additional procurement costs and potential delays. Developing a separate program with a new vendor would require extensive resources and reconfiguration of current workflows.

What efforts were made to determine there was no competition for the service or good and how was it determined the price for the purchase is fair and reasonable?

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It would be counter productive to seek out another medical provider due to communication and oversight costs. In addition, it could be counter productive to the individual Inmate's as this would result in them having two different medical providers with potentially different objectives.
