<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Michael Clark for District 2, has determined that \$2,500.00 will be granted to The Retired Investigators Guild to support its work to restore faith in law enforcement through its primary focus of solving cold case crimes; and

WHEREAS, The Retired Investigators Guild is comprised of volunteer retired and former criminal investigators who are selected through a rigorous process based on their distinguished careers in major case investigations; and

WHEREAS, The Retired Investigators Guild's goal is simple: to ensure that major investigations, including cold cases, receive the attention and expertise they deserve; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to The Retired Investigators Guild a grant for fiscal year 2024-2025 in the amount of \$2,500.00.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
- 4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
