

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Alexis Hill for District 1, has determined that \$5,000.00 will be granted to Amplify Life for the purpose of supporting programs for clients with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Amplify Life mission is that all people should be able to live full, healthy, meaningful lives serving adults with disabilities by providing programs; and

WHEREAS, the various Amplify Life year-round programs include Prevocational, Social/Recreational, Camp Lotsafun, Life Skills, Friendship and Dating Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to the Tahoe Fund for the purpose of supporting Amplify Life program, a grant for fiscal year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$5,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents surrounding Lake Tahoe by supporting activities that highlight the preservation of the Lake Tahoe Basin and the environmental issues facing restoration efforts.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
