I returned to my alma mater (Reed High School) in 1996 before teaching at Vaughn Middle School and North Valleys High School. Currently, I am serving as President of the Washoe Education Association and have previously served as a Director of the National Education Association and Board member of the Nevada State Education Association. In addition to the work with professional education organizations, I also serve on the Board of Directors for Truckee Meadows Tomorrow and WCSD Education Alliance.

I grew up surrounded by books, politics and a love of Nevada. Coming from a family of educators, I learned the importance of politics in education and community involvement at a young age. I've worked with numerous elected officials including Jan Evans, Bob Sader, Bernice Martin Mathews, Jim Shaw, Debbie Smith, Joe Dini, and my father Bernie Anderson. I have been a consistent voice at the legislature, lobbying for public education for two decades. In 2016, I had the pleasure of working with numerous Northern Nevadans on the WC-1 campaign to help build and revitalize Washoe's school facilities.
